NOTES

LIPMAN LEDGER: The Fisher Cats look to close the 2025 season with a win, and a sweep of the Baysox after last night's 2-1 walk-off. Down 1-0 entering the ninth, the Fisher Cats loaded the bases on singles by Damiano Palmegiani and Je'Von Ward, and a walk to Cade Dougherty. A wild pitch scored the first run before Eddinson Paulino delighted the crowd of 6,324 with a winning single. It was the second walk-off win in four nights, and the first time New Hampshire had won a game this season when trailing after eight innings...The Fisher Cats have never swept a six-game series. They had a chance against Altoona at home in June, but the Curve won the finale...Charles McAdoo had two hits last year and will finish as New Hampshire's leader in 2025 in hits, doubles, homers, RBIs, walks, and stolen bases. His 490 plate appearances are the most on the team, well ahead of Ryan McCarty's 373...Grant Rogers will make his 20th start of the season, the most on the 2025 team. He leads with seven wins and 104.2 IP.

ON THIS DATE: September 14 - The Fisher Cats earned Championship series wins on this date in 2004, 2011, and 2018. In 2004, the Fisher Cats won the finals opener in Altoona 5-4. **Dominic Rich** had two hits, including the game-winning RBI double in the top of the eighth inning. In 2011, New Hampshire drew even at 1-1 with Richmond in Game 2 of the finals with a 7-5 win at Delta Dental Stadium. The Fisher Cats took the lead with three in the second inning, and received a strong start from **Nestor Molina** (5.0 IP - 1 ER - 8 K). In 2018, the Fisher Cats won the third championship in team history with an 8-5 win at Delta Dental Stadium to sweep Akron. **Cavan Biggio** homered, **Jon Berti** went 3-for-4 with two RBIs, and **Harold Ramirez** also plated two runners.

AFL ROSTERS: The Glendale Desert Dogs will roster seven Blue Jays farmhands in the 2025 Arizona Fall League, with five former Fisher Cats and four having played in NH in 2025: **Josh Kasevich**, SS (No. 13); **Edward Duran**, C (No. 14); **Angel Bastardo**, RHP (No. 30); **Alex Amalfi**, RHP; **Kai Peterson**, LHP; **Yondrei Rojas**, RHP; **Chay Yeager**, RHP. Bastardo was acquired via Rule 5 in December and has spent all year on the IL, recovering from TJ surgery. **Duran** and **Bastardo** are the two no-names in New Hampshire; **Kasevich** played for the Cats in 2024 while **Amalfi**, **Peterson**, **Rojas** and **Yeager** are all on the current roster.

AROUND THE NEST: The **Blue Jays (86-62)** scored three in the bottom of the ninth and beat the Orioles, 5-4. The Yankees won in Boston, 5-3, so Toronto's lead stays at three games heading into play Sunday. **Alejandro Kirk** had a sac fly to win the game, making a winner out of **Braydon Fisher**, who improves to 6-0... **Triple-A Buffalo (29-37, 59-80)** broke a 3-3 tie in the ninth on a **Phil Clarke** single to beat Rochester, 4-3. The Bisons had built a 3-0 lead in the first, but the Red Wings tied it in the sixth. **Josh Kasevich** had a pair of hits.

SINCE WE LAST MET: Since the last time these two faced off, Toronto released righties **Michael Dominguez**, **Grayson Thurman**, and **Johnathan Lavallee**. New faces include **Raimundo De Los Santos**, pitchers **Fernando Perez**, **Johan Simon**, **Yondrei Rojas** and **Kai Peterson** and **Damiano Palmegiani** joined from Buffalo last week. RHP **Ryan Watson** was moved to the 60-Day IL before the end of August. RHP **Gage Stanifer** and now **JR Freethy** have each joined New Hampshire's roster, as well.

2026 AT CLUB NEDD: The Fisher Cats open 2026 with a three-game series against **Binghamton** in Manchester for the second year in a row. Sandwiched in between another home matchup with the Ponies (April 28-May 3) is a six-game series with **Chesapeake**. From May 12-24, the Fisher Cats host **Reading** and **Hartford** in their lone back-to-back homestand of the summer. June sees the Cats open with **Altoona** before one of two back-to-back road trips and end the month against **Somerset**. After spending July 4 on the road, New Hampshire hosts **Portland** and **Somerset** in July before the Sea Dogs return to open August. After Hartford's visit to end the month, the Cats end 2026 at home against **Harrisburg**.

CATS IN THE MAJORS: Fisher Cats 2024 pitcher **Lázaro Estrada** became the sixth former Fisher Cats player to make his debut in The Show on July 5 and 172 all-time. Estrada joins the list of **Will Robertson (6/15/25 @PHI)**, **Braydon Fisher (5/11/2025 @SEA)**, **Paxton Schultz (4/20/25 @SEA)**, **Alan Roden (3/27/25 vs BAL)** and **Mason Fлуharty (4/1/25 vs WAS)**.

NEW HAMPSHIRE FIELD STAFF - 2025



BRENT LAVALLEE - MANAGER (1ST SEASON)

A native of North Delta, British Columbia, Canada, **Lavallee** (luh-VALLEY) ventured 3,000 miles away from home to LSU Shreveport for a full-ride scholarship. Over the course of 15 years, **Lavallee** traversed the ranks of the Pilots baseball program as a player, assistant coach, and manager. Lavallee made his managerial pro debut with Toronto with the FCL Blue Jays in 2021. 2025 will be **Lavallee's** fifth summer in the Blue Jays organization. **Lavallee** became the fourth Vancouver manager since 1951 to cross the 200-win threshold and departed The Nat with a Northwest League championship showing in all three of his seasons ('21-'23).



MITCH HUCKABAY - HITTING COACH (3RD SEASON)

Huckabay returns for his third season with the Fisher Cats in 2025 and is reunited with the new manager **Lavallee**. Prior to tenures at Sam Houston State, Northeast Texas CC and Vernon College, **Huckabay** was on **Lavallee's** staff at LSU Shreveport in 2018 and 2019 for his first full-time coaching role, where the two helped the Pilots win back-to-back Red River Athletic Conference regular-season championships. **Huckabay** joined Toronto's organization from the college ranks in 2023.



AUSTIN BIBENS-DIRKX - (1ST SEASON)

Bibens-Dirkx last donned a Fisher Cats uniform on 9/6/15 when he fired seven innings and struck out eight batters to earn the win in Trenton. The former big-leaguer **Bibens-Dirkx** is set to return to New Hampshire, this time as pitching coach, and becomes the sixth Fisher Cats alum to return to Manchester in a coaching role. Born in Salem, Oregon, **Bibens-Dirkx** appeared in 49 games with the Fisher Cats from 2013 through 2015 ahead of his Major League debut in 2017. As pitching coach in Vancouver in 2024, **Bibens-Dirkx** oversaw a staff that slung 14 shutout wins and the second-lowest WHIP (1.30) in the Northwest League.



JAKE MCGUIGGAN - (2ND SEASON)

McGuiggan returns to the Fisher Cats for his second season in the same role in New Hampshire. A native New Englander from Hingham, Massachusetts, **McGuiggan** joined the Fisher Cats staff in 2024 after spending the prior three seasons as development coach with the Triple-A Buffalo Bisons. Beginning as a Minor League Video Assistant with the Blue Jays in 2018, **McGuiggan** attended Harvard University and slashed .347/.362/.504 in his senior campaign with the Crimson in 2015.



DELTA CLEARY JR. - (2ND SEASON)

Cleary Jr. returns for his second year with the Fisher Cats in 2025 as position coach. From Jonesboro, Arkansas, **Cleary Jr.** was named an NJCAA All-American and helped lead LSU Eunice to win the 2008 NJCAA Division II World Series. The Colorado Rockies selected **Cleary Jr.** in the 37th Round of the 2008 MLB Draft and would eventually play in 699 games across a seven-year career in the Minors with the Rockies and Washington Nationals. **Cleary Jr.** also played in the Mexican Pacific and Venezuelan Winter Leagues in between seasons with the Long Island Ducks from 2015 through 2017.



THOMAS CAULFIELD - (1ST SEASON)

Caulfield joins the Cats coaching staff as bullpen coach in 2025, his first year in the Blue Jays organization. Prior to this year, **Caulfield** joined the Saint Mary's College baseball coaching staff in July 2023. **Caulfield** played collegiately at Skyline College and Chicago State before transferring to the University of San Francisco. The Burlingame, California native spent three seasons in the Pioneer League and Frontier League and ended his playing days with the Spire City Ghost Hounds in the MLB-Partner Atlantic League.

2025: Promoted to Double-A on May 20... Began season with High-A Vancouver: **3-1 in 8 games, all starts. 39 K with 18 BB...** Departed VAN as team's leader in IP (39.2), ERA (1.82) and tied for most W (3) and most starts (8)... Made Double-A debut against Somerset on 5/21, carried four perfect innings into a three-run fifth (two ER) and took a bad-luck loss... Tossed seven innings against Portland on July 1, his longest start since he threw seven innings on 8/24/24 for Vancouver vs Everett. Cats scored two in the first, two in the second, didn't score again the rest of the game... Earned second win of the month on July 23 with his seventh quality start, has only received the win in three of seven QSs... Fell one out shy of eighth QS with 5.2 IP in Bowie on July 30. Had two outs in sixth inning on five pitches before a checked-swing double, a 2-run HR and a single pulled him from the game... Chucked eighth 6.0+ IP start with the Cats for his third straight winning decision on August 5. 2-0 with a 2.00 ERA across 18.0 IP in August. Tossed 10th QS with NH on August 16 in Binghamton. Matched his Double-A high with 6 Ks and and didn't allow a walk... ERA flinched with five runs in five IP in Akron on August 22. Had two outs in first before single/2R HR... Earned first win since August 16 with five innings against Chesapeake...

2024: Played April - July in Single-A Dunedin in first pro summer in Blue Jays system. Struck out 7+ batters in six starts between Single-A Dunedin and High-A Vancouver... In his High-A debut, threw an insane 8.0 shutout innings on 99 pitches, 68 strikes to drive a 4-0 shutout win at The Nat over Tri-City. Current Fisher Cats teammate Grayson Thurman completed the shutout win with the ninth. Earned NWL's Pitcher of the Week for his accomplishment... Started the C's elimination game on September 14th in Spokane and held off the Indians as long as he could: 6.1 IP, 5 H, 1 R, 0 BB, 5 K. Spokane walked off Vancouver with two runs in the bottom of the 10th for the Northwest League title...

ABOUT GRANT: Nickname is "Big Bird", is mortified of birds... Drafted out of McNeese State by Toronto in the 11th Round of the 2023 MLB Draft... Was a 2x Southland Conference Pitcher of the Year and finished his draft summer 12-1 with a 1.82 ERA with the Cowboys... Rogers' 1.82 ERA led the Southland Conference and was third-best in the nation in 2023 behind Paul Skenes (1.69) and freshman Jackson Wells (1.65) at Arkansas-Little Rock...In an article with an ABC affiliate in Beaumont, Texas: "I'm pretty scared of birds," Grant said. "That's one of my worst fears, but go Blue Jays..."
